

Standards and Criteria for Selecting TIGERS Projects

Proposal Categories

Addresses at least one of the current year's TIGERS proposal categories as indicated in the Request for Proposals.

Strategic Applicability

Addresses an important common need among academic technology operations at California State University campuses.

Timely Results

Can be accomplished in the timeframe indicated in the proposal. Scope of the project is realistic.

Feasibility

Can be accomplished with the resources requested in the proposal, e.g., staff time, with consideration toward the requirements of the project personnel's regular duties.

Acceptance

Can be implemented in a way that provides for ongoing discussion and validation of the approaches taken.

Scalability

Is planned and developed once; can be easily shared or implemented on multiple campuses.

Sustainability

Can be supported after the project period through existing, stable sources of funding and approval processes, and can deal effectively with the problems of technical obsolescence and need for continuous quality improvement.

Accountability

Sound evaluation metrics are included to monitor the achievement of the project's objectives and outcomes.

Multicampus Participation

Involves significant, active participation of academic technology staff from multiple campuses in planning, implementing, managing and evaluating project activities.
